## Instructions to Authors

### TIMING FOR SUBMISSIONS

There will be three issues: Winter (January), Spring (April), Fall (September). Articles should be submitted approximately eight weeks prior to the first of the publication month.

### FORMAT FOR ARTICLES

- The text of all articles should be transmitted as a Word document and formatted in a single column. PowerPoint and Internet Clip Art should be avoided.
- Begin with an abstract of no more than one paragraph (200 to 300 words). Do not include references, figures, tables, or equations in the abstract.
- Figures and illustrations should be transmitted as separate files, not embedded in the Word document. Photographs and line drawings should be of the highest quality and, if not created digitally, should be scanned at high resolution: photographs at 300 dpi at final size; hand-drawn line drawings at least 600 dpi at final size. All graphs, diagrams, photos, etc. should be saved in one of the following formats: JPG, TIF, PNG, or EPS.
- Equations should be formatted using Microsoft Word's native Equation Editor
  - Use italics for all symbols for scalar quantities, including those represented by Greek letters
  - Set vectors in boldface lowercase roman (regular) letters, and set matrices and tensors in boldface capital roman letters
- Technical articles should be no more than 2,000 words long (including References) and should include no more than 6 figures per article
- Nontechnical articles (departments, event wrap-ups, interviews, etc.) should be no more than 900 words long
- Include references compiled in the standard reference format recommended by SEG. For proper reference style and format, refer to the Manuscript Preparation section of the GEOPHYSICS Instructions to Authors at <https://library.seg.org/GEO-references>
- Have full company approval for publication
